## DUNGOG/STROUD ROAD SHORT EXCURSION

This tour is intended for groups that want a short excursion to experience riding on our rail motors without the commitment to a full day hire. The trip will operate from our Depot at Paterson and will run to Dungog, Monkerai or Stroud Road depending upon the time you have available and the availability of a suitable train path from the network owner. This trip takes approximately 2 - 3 hours.

You will enjoy the excellent lower North Coast scenery as we travel up the Paterson River Valley before passing through Wallarobba Tunnel into the Williams River Valley, then travel on through Monkerai Tunnel into the Karuah River Valley. Morning or afternoon tea will be served to you on the journey.
